Community clean-up and beautification coming to South Hayward Harder- Tennyson neighborhood

The Keep Hayward Clean and Green Task Force invites volunteers to register for and join a neighborhood litter collection event—8:30 a.m. to noon on Saturday, Feb. 24, starting at Tyrrell Elementary School

HAYWARD, Calif., Feb. 15, 2018—The Keep Hayward Clean and Green Task Force takes its annual program of monthly community clean-up and beautification events to South Hayward on Feb. 24 with a litter-collection event starting at Tyrrell Elementary School.

The Harder-Tennyson neighborhood around Tyrrell Elementary is home to numerous schools, churches and faith-based organizations, and parks and other open spaces.

Starting at 8:30 a.m. Saturday, Feb. 24, the city Maintenance Services Department will be on hand to team up with Keep Hayward Clean and Green Task Force and community members who want to get involved and volunteer.

After the work is finished by about noon, participants are encouraged to share their experience on social media, using the *#HaywardBeautiful* hash-tag.

Volunteers can save time by pre-registering through the City of Hayward [website](#)—but anyone and everyone is welcome to show up and sign up at the event at Tyrrell Elementary, located at 27000 Tyrrell Ave., between Shepherd Avenue and Schafer Road.

The Keep Hayward Clean and Green Task Force was formed by the City Council in 2007. It has 30 members who are appointed to four year terms. Its mission is to improve the environment and enhance the visual appearance of the City of Hayward through the joint efforts of individuals, volunteer groups, businesses and municipal resources.

The Task Force meets the fourth Thursday of the month at 7 p.m. in City Hall Conference Room 2A at 777 B Street. Its monthly clean-up and beautification events take place the fourth Saturday of the month.
